Horticulture Challenge

2018 Theme: Christmas in July

The goal of this challenge is to create a unique display garden with a variety of plants. All types of plants are acceptable including fruits and vegetables, annuals and perennials, shrubs and trees. There will be a theme as to the type of display to be used for this challenge.

There are two rules for this challenge:

1. The display must conform to the “Christmas in July” theme for 2018; this is to ensure uniformity throughout the challenge. Some freedoms can be taken with the display.
2. Use your creativity and imagination to create your display garden. There are no limitations to the garden you create. Some examples are a vegetable garden, Zen garden, and flower bed.

Helpful Tips:

- Establish a design.
- You may want to plan to assemble your display at the show during entry times; this may be easier than transporting the display as a whole.
- Grow all plants to be used in individual pots.
- Grow extra plants.
- Use stones, mulch, signage, and other landscaping materials.
- Bring extra soil, mulch, etc. to use during assembly.
- If possible, provide a watering container (e.g., 1 gallon plastic jug) to be used during the fair.
